<p><u>Issue No. 11</u></p> <p>Whether the target users of the AI system are the same with the users of the existing AML/Fraud Management system.</p>	<p><u>Clarification/Amendment No. 11</u></p> <p>No. Target users of AI solution covers both users of datamining/monitoring system, as well as other users within AMLC.</p>
<p><u>Issue No. 12</u></p> <p>Whether the AI result/output are expected to be passed to existing AML/Fraud Management System.</p>	<p><u>Clarification/Amendment No. 12</u></p> <p>Part of the result of AI solution will be used by the existing datamining/monitoring system particularly the output of Functionality No. 1.</p>
<p><u>Issue No. 13</u></p> <p>Whether the users are expecting one User Interface for analyzing suspicious transactions and associated relevant information.</p>	<p><u>Clarification/Amendment No. 13</u></p> <p>The users prefer to have one User Interface for ease of use, but this is not mandatory.</p>
