Technical Specifications</p> <p>The prospective bidder is requesting to consider technologies and brands that were not included in the list of Gartner Magic Quadrant for Wired and Wireless LAN Access Infrastructure for 2019.</p>	<p><u>CLARIFICATION No. 1:</u></p> <p>The requirement for the proposed technologies and brand of equipment must be included in the list of Gartner Magic Quadrant for Wired and Wireless LAN Access Infrastructure for 2019 is a consensus and recommendatory decision from the concerned IT groups of AMLCS that conducted thorough analysis of competing markets that provides an insight and serves as a guide in evaluating and selecting a technology and/or service provider/vendor that will maximize (take full advantage) for the security requirements, deployment of mission-critical applications as well as future-proofing requisites of the AMLCS.</p>

Technical Specifications</p> <p>The prospective bidder is requesting to consider technologies that were not able to support 4G and GPS.</p>	<p><u>CLARIFICATION No. 2:</u></p> <p>Mobile access point device must be able to support 4G and GPS, considering that 4G has strong signal with good data speeds, while GPS is a prerequisite in obtaining a stable 4G signal relative to data throughput.</p>
